Use Of Loading Tables

Calculation Method

The published safe working loads are based on tests with perforated (slotted) rail. For non perforated rail the safe working loads can be taken as 20% higher.

Loads are calculated taking into consideration a maximum deflection (f) of length $1/200 \times L$ and a maximum bending stress of 160 N/mm2. (figure A)

1 N (Newton) = 0.22 lbs. 2.2 lbs. = 8.89 N (Newton)

Installing rails to walls or ceilings

The strength of the anchoring of the rail has not been taken into consideration. The installer must verify that the bolts and wall plugs used are suitable for the maximum permitted loading of the rail. (figure B)

Methods of loading

Where loads are suspended beneath rails, the load must not exceed the relevant safe load of the slide nut. To increase rigidity of the installation we recommend the use of a U-formed washer. (figure C)


Reading the rail loading tables

The stated values are only valid for the fixing rail. The maximum safe load of all other construction parts have to be verified. The stated maximum safe load is calculated for a static load at free bending support. (figure D)

Where the segment is marked with a hyphen, the stated length cannot be safely loaded.

Noise Insulation in Pipe Work Systems

Sources of noise

Pipe work systems installed for fluid supply, heating and sanitary purposes, as well as ductwork systems for air conditioning, can act as conductors of acoustic vibrations. These vibrations arise from the flow of the medium in the system, the method of system connection and pumps, fans, valves etc.

Statutory regulations

If a system conducting the acoustic vibrations mentioned above is directly fixed to walls or ceilings the noise level can increase because the building structure acts as an amplifier. Building regulations state a maximum permissible transmitted noise level from pipe work systems (see DIN 4109). Currently this residual valve is 35 dB (A) future regulation is expected to reduce this level.

Noise insulation by pipe clamps

To reduce the transmission of acoustic vibrations in pipe work to the building structure, a layer of acoustic vibration absorbing material must be placed between the pipe work and all support fixing points. It is essential that the support fixing point into the building structure is never directly in contact with the pipe work. The smallest direct contact will act as a sound carrying bridge. Therefore, the acoustic vibration absorbing material needs to be specifically designed for each pipe clamp support.


Maximizing noise insulation

The acoustic vibration absorbing materials used in our products are rubber profiles. Since rubber is elastic the transmission of acoustic vibrations is considerably reduced. The shape of the rubber profile is specifically designed for each clamp to eliminate contact between pipe and clamp.

We have also paid considerable attention to the cross section of the rubber profile by introducing grooves which maximize absorption of acoustic vibrations.

Quality of the rubber lining

The rubber lining must be durable and capable of retaining its elastic qualities to adequately absorb acoustic vibrations over a prolonged period. In consultation with rubber technology experts we have established performance standards to optimize aging resistance. The rubber profiles which we use are regularly tested against these performance standards independent specialist testing institutes.



Test certification

The reduction in noise transmission by use of our rubber lined pipe clamps tested by independent institutes on the basis of the requirements of DIN 4109.

The test method employed is that described in DIN 52 218 for measurement of noise transmission reduction of rubber linings.

Original test certificates are available upon request.

Please note the recorded RESIDUAL VALUE of noise transmission is that achieved by the DIN 52 218 test and measurement method at 3 bar.

Rubber temperature performance

EPDM rubber (both black and green) has been designed for an operating temperature range of minus 58° F up to plus 200° F, continuous. For a peak situation it can be plus 250° F.

For steam pipes a special silicon rubber profile (red) is available, allowing for an operating temperature of 390° F, continuous and 420° F peak.

Information: Surface Treatment

To improve the corrosion resistance of steel products, Walraven uses all kinds of methods. Below you will find an overview:

BIS UltraProtect® 1000 system

The BIS UltraProtect® 1000 system is the ideal and most durable solution for securing or supporting mechanical installations, solar systems and many other types of installations.



The products in the BIS UltraProtect® 1000 system have very high corrosion resistance. They effortlessly withstand a salt spray test of at least 1000 hours* (in accordance with ISO 9227). The salt spray test shows that the corrosion resistance of BIS UltraProtect® 1000 products is considerably higher than that of, for example, Hot Dip Galvanized products (approximately 300–600 hours).

Although the system utilities a relatively thin protective coating, the corrosion resistance is high. Not only does the BIS UltraProtect® 1000 system offer a smooth and fine finish, the products are also visually appealing. An additional benefit of the relatively thin protective coating is that threaded products are also well protected against corrosion. The BIS UltraProtect® 1000 products, including threaded items such as bolts, nuts and threaded rods, have superior corrosion resistance and will last at least 20 years**!

Zinc Plating

The products to be treated are cleaned, degreased and pickled. The protective coating is then applied in an electrolytic process. The thickness of the layer of zinc is between 1 and 20 μm (0.001 – 0.020 mm) and is determined by the current intensity and the duration of the galvanizing process. After the galvanizing process the products are passivated to extend the protection period.

Pre-galvanized

Also known as Sendzimir galvanization. Pre-galvanizing is a continuous thermal galvanizing process. The strip steel is guided through a bath containing liquid zinc after having been cleaned, degreased and pickled. Later the steel is cut to the required width. The sides of this cut material are not galvanized. This is also the case with any holes that may be drilled in the pre-galvanized material.

The sides of material thinner than 1,5 mm are protected somewhat by the zinc layer on the top and bottom by the electrolytic process of 'pulling together'.

This method is excellently suited for products with a screw thread, which are to be used indoors or in a non-corrosive environment.

Hot-Dip Galvanizing

Also known as 'thermal galvanizing', 'full bath galvanizing' or 'centrifugal galvanizing'. The products to be treated are cleaned, degreased and pickled and subsequently put into an immersion bath of liquid zinc. The immersion bath has a temperature of 1022° F. In this process an alloy of zinc/iron develops on the surface and is then covered by a layer of pure zinc.

The thickness of the zinc layer varies between 50 and 150 μm (0.050 – 0.150 mm). In consequence the process is less suitable for products with screw thread. Hot–dip galvanized products are suitable for inside as well as outside use and also for damp and light–corrosive environments.

Delta-Tone 9000

Delta-Tone 9000 consists of zinc and aluminum particles that are held together by an inorganic binder. This offers an effective protection against corrosion even with a limited layer of thickness.

Delta-Tone 9000 is applied in an immersion/centrifugal or spray process and then dried at a temperature of 392° F. With this method an even layer is formed over the whole product with a thickness of 10 – 12 μm . Subsequently Delta-Tone 9000 forms a connection with the metal underneath and the surface consists of a layer of inorganic material with zinc and aluminum flakes. In contrast to electrolytic and thermal galvanizing, with Delta-Tone 9000 there is no danger of hydrogen embrittlement in materials with an increased carbon content, such as spring steel.

To improve the corrosion resistance, the process can be repeated which increases the thickness each time by $10 - 12 \mu m$.

Products protected by Delta-Tone 9000 are suitable for outside use as well as moderate corrosive environments.

Stainless Steel 316 (1.4401)

Stainless steel 316 is one of the best corrosion resistant types of stainless steel. It offers a superior corrosion resistance compared to many other types of stainless steel in very many corrosive environments.

The protective layer is damaged by treatments such as punching, rilling and welding. That is why, after the last treatment, all stainless steel products receive an extra treatment which pickles and passivates to repair the protective layer.

Products from stainless steel 316 can be applied in aggressive situations such as a sea climate and industry.

Information: Surface Treatment

Salt-spray test

To compare the protection duration of various surface treatments, a salt-spray test is carried out according to ISO 9227. In this test products are placed in a space and sprayed with a salt solution. The products will start to corrode. The point at which "white" and then "red" rust appears is noted.

This test does not give a perfect protection duration (this depends on the surroundings in which the product is applied), but does offer a comparative view of the various surface treatments.

7. PAYMENT TERMS

12. WARRANTY
